

Meet soon on auto sector growth: Min

The heavy industries and public enterprises Ministry will soon convene a stakeholder meeting to discuss ways for fast-track growth of the automobile industry, including e-vehicles, Union Minister Prakash Javadekar said on Tuesday.

He also said with the development of NATRAX (National Automotive Test Tracks) Indore facility, domestic vehicles will no longer need to be sent abroad for testing.

Now many countries which do not have this kind of facilities will send their vehicles

to India instead of Europe or the US because the 11.3-km high speed track at Indore is the fifth largest in the world, but largest in Asia and more equipped than facilities in China and Japan, the minister said.

"We will arrange a stakeholder dialogue very soon to think about both the topics - further acceleration for high growth of the automobile industry and what is the way forward for fast-tracking and fast growth of e-vehicles," the Minister for Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises said while inaugurating the Indore facility.

Javadekar added that many ideas are floating around on e-vehicles and there are newer solutions coming up, "so we will hold stakeholder consultation in both the areas very soon".

Speaking at the event, former Mahindra and Mahindra MD Pawan Goenka said in spite of the central and state governments' initiatives to facilitate transition to e-vehicles, it is happening at a very slow pace and there is a need for stakeholder consultation to fast-track the transition.

"We cannot afford the slow pace at which the transition is happening today," he said.

Goenka also said the auto industry today in India is bruised as even before the pandemic, it was almost stagnant for five years.

Again, there is a need for a stakeholder meeting to see what needs to be done to get the industry back on the growth path as the industry is important for economic growth.

New pandemic package to raise fiscal deficit by 60 bps: Report

The latest credit push for the pandemic-hit sectors and other relief supports will have an additional 60 bps impact on the fiscal deficit, and can offer an additional liquidity window of ₹70,000 crore to banks, says a report.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday announced ₹1.5 lakh-crore of additional credit for small businesses, more funds for the healthcare sector, loans to tourism agencies and guides, and waiver of visa fees as part of a credit-led package to support the pandemic-hit economy.

The package, mostly made up of Government guarantees

to banks and microfinance institutions for loans they extend to the pandemic-hit sectors, totals up to ₹6.29 lakh crore together with the previous such packages.

Assuming equal distribution of the new announcement of ₹1.10 lakh crore, with 50 per cent and 75 per cent guarantee cover and a risk weight of 100 per cent, banks may have a capital relief of around ₹7,500 crore that can further generate credit of around ₹70,000 crore, according to an SBI Research analysis.

The fiscal impact of latest announcements and earlier is not linear as a substantial portion of the package is contingent liabilities. Ignoring these,

the immediate impact will be slightly over ₹1.23 lakh crore which will be around 0.6 per cent of the GDP, SBI chief economist Soumya Kanti Ghosh said in the report.

Monday's announcement broadly emphasises four sectors - health, tourism, MFIs and agriculture.

The other measures announced fine-tune the scope of the already existing arrange-

ments, he said.

Under the credit guarantee schemes to further the flow of credit to the weaker sections of the society, guarantees will be provided to banks for loans to new or existing NBFC-MFIs or MFIs for lending up to ₹1.25 lakh to around 25 lakh small borrowers.

Interest rate on such loans will be capped at MCLR plus 2 per cent.

Jet Airways shares continue to rise

MONITORING COMMITTEE FOR AIRLINE IN PLACE

Continuing on its upward trajectory, shares of grounded Jet Airways gained nearly five per cent to touch its upper price limit on Tuesday.

Since National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approved Jalan Kalrock Consortium's resolution plan for the airline on June 22, the scrip has been on the rise.

On Tuesday, it closed at ₹ 126.80 apiece - also the upper price band - on the BSE. It ended at the same level on the NSE too.

The stock had climbed 4.96 per cent to Rs 99.45 on both the BSE and NSE on June 22, the day NCLT approved the resolution plan for the carrier.

A seven-member monitoring committee has been constituted to manage the day-to-day affairs of Jet Airways till the insolvency resolution process is complete.

Economic activities in rural India fared better in lockdown 2.0: Survey

Smart Power India (SPI), a subsidiary of the Rockefeller Foundation, has released the results of their survey titled "SPI's Survey of Mini-grid Villages May 2021" which shows that overall economic activity in such villages was less affected in 2021 due to the pandemic that largely impacted the healthcare and educational sector.

The survey was carried out to assess the impact of Covid-19, with a sample size of 200 respondents across 48 villages in the states of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar.

It was learnt that while overall economic activity in mini-grid villages was less affected in 2021, the impact on education and healthcare infrastructure was much worse compared to 2020. SPI conducts these surveys periodically to stay abreast of evolving issues the rural Indian consumer is dealing with, in the light of the pandemic.

According to recent SPI surveys conducted in mini-grid villages, 61% of the participants

responded that availability of essential services this year was better than the lockdown in 2020.

Family income also showed improvement as compared to the first lockdown as 29% of the respondents expressed that 10 to 25% of their family income this year was impacted due to the lockdown due to better preparedness. Around 1.6% of the respondents faced no impact of the lockdown on their incomes.

This improvement in the family incomes in rural areas can be attributed to reliable access to electricity that has been consistent towards the rural communities amidst both the lockdowns in 2020 and 2021. 67% of the respondents of the survey expressed satisfaction with the quality and availability of reliable electricity from mini-grids.

Though India's economy reflected the signs of recovery after the first wave peaked in September 2020, this recovery wasn't consistent. Income, employment and health were still key concerns for rural communities.

Pradhan puts ONGC, OIL on notice: Perform or get shipped out

Petroleum Minister Dharmendra Pradhan on Tuesday put State-owned ONGC and OIL on notice saying oil and gas reserves they hold need to be monetised through joint ventures with domain experts or the government will take them away and auction them.

Speaking at BNEF Summit, he said state-owned firms cannot indefinitely sit on resources when the nation is a net importer of oil and gas.

Despite India bidding out acreages to private and other companies since the 1990s, Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) and Oil India Ltd (OIL) hold a "sizeable number of acreage for years," he said.

"We have asked them to do two things - do it yourself, (produce oil and gas) through some joint venture (with domain experts and foreign companies) (and) through a new business model. But the government cannot permit you to hold resources for an indefinite time," he said.



ONGC and OIL, which discovered and brought to production all of India's eight sedimentary basins, produce about three-fourths of the nation's oil and gas.

The two, especially ONGC, have faced criticism ranging from not being able to quickly bring discoveries to production to lower recovery.

Pradhan said India needs energy for its ambitious economic growth agenda. "We want to reduce import dependency. We want to monetise our own resources."

"So we have given policy guidance to our state-owned oil companies - either you do on your own through new partners and new economic model, (else) the government will after a particular period .

Sebi decides to introduce framework for accredited investors

Sebi on Tuesday decided to introduce a framework for accredited investors, a class of investors who may be considered as well-informed about investment products, in the Indian securities market. The board of Sebi after deliberation approved the proposal to introduce a framework for accredited investors. Under the proposed framework, individuals,

HUFs, family trusts, sole proprietorships, partnership firms, trusts and body Corporates based on financial parameters would be eligible for accreditation of investors, Sebi said in a statement after the board meeting. The accreditation of investors should be carried out through "Accreditation Agencies" like subsidiaries of depositories and specified stock exchanges, and any other specified institutions.

Markets extend losses to second day

Equity indices languished for the second straight session on Tuesday as investors pared back their exposure to riskier assets amid a cautious trend in global markets due to a fresh spurt in Covid-19 cases in many countries.

A weakeninging rupee and the fiscal impact of the government's new stimulus measures also sapped risk appetite,

traders said. The 30-share BSE Sensex ended 185.93 points or 0.35 per cent lower at 52,549.66. Similarly, the broader NSE Nifty tumbled 66.25 points or 0.42 per cent to 15,748.45.

Kotak Bank was the top loser among the Sensex constituents, shedding 1.54 per cent, followed by ICICI Bank, Tech Mahindra, Bajaj Auto, Axis Bank, Mahindra and Mahindra, SBI and Maruti.
